Measures for using the Imaging Core Microscope Room

In using the Imaging Core Microscope Room and equipment, the following must be observed. This is a measure to prevent infections between users.

(Reservation of microscope and equipment)

- 1. In line with the relaxation of activity level to 0.5 from 13. July at the University of Tokyo, Imaging Core microscope rooms are available for 24 hr. including Saturday, Sunday and national holidays from the same day afternoon.
- 2. Please make a reservation for the microscope by the day before. This is because the reservation status of the microscope is grasped in advance and the working hours of the person in charge next day are decided. We have been advised to work as staggered working hours and tele-work whenever possible.
- 3. When making a microscope reservation, please reserve a minimum of 30 minutes between users in order to reduce contact with users before and after, and to secure the time for disinfection on the part of the administrator.

[Before entering the microscope room]

- 4. The body temperature must be measured with a non-contact thermometer, and if the temperature is 37.5 °C or higher, entry is not permitted. Also, you cannot enter the room if you have a physical condition such as a cold, cough, or fatigue.
- 5. Disinfect with the ethanol, and wear gloves and a mask. Users must wear gloves and a mask in the microscope room until you leave there.

[After entering the microscope room]

- 6. Do not touch shoes or slippers with gloved hands. Do not use a shoe box, leave your shoes off and your slippers out.
- 7. If you do not wear glasses when observing through the eyepieces, bring protective glasses as much as possible and wear them. This is to prevent infection caused by eye contact through the eyepiece lens.

[When leaving the microscope room]

8. After using the microscope, remove the gloves and mask outside the microscope room and throw them into the designated trash can installed in the corridor. Do not reuse gloves and masks.
